

Charles and Jean Gottfried Scholarship

Program Information

The Charles and Jean Gottfried Scholarship is available for graduating high school seniors residing in Wyandot County, Ohio who demonstrate leadership characteristics and are planning to enroll as a full-time undergraduate or Career-Technical Education (CTE) student at an accredited post-secondary institution. This scholarship is renewable for 1 additional year after the initial award (2 years total), provided applicant meets the renewal conditions.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Applications are first carefully reviewed by the Community Foundation staff to verify their eligibility.

1. Must reside in Wyandot County, Ohio.
2. Must plan to enroll as a full-time student.
3. Must be pursuing an undergraduate degree **OR** Career-Technical Education (CTE) program at an accredited post-secondary institution. *(Must be a non-profit institution.)*

SELECTION CRITERIA

Eligible applicants are reviewed by a Scholarship Advisory Committee (SAC) based on the following criteria, in order of significance.

1. Financial Need
2. Academic Achievements
3. Test Scores (Scholastic Aptitude)
4. Community Service & Volunteer Involvement
5. Leadership Skills & Experience
6. Extracurricular Involvement
7. Work Experience
