

Charles and Jean Gottfried Scholarship

Program Information

The Charles and Jean Gottfried Scholarship was established in 2010 for graduating high school seniors residing in Wyandot County, Ohio who are planning to enroll as full-time undergraduate students at an accredited post-secondary institution of their choice. Several scholarship of at least **\$1,000** will be awarded each year. This scholarship may be renewed for 1 additional year after the initial award provided the applicant shows progress toward their degree.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

1. Must be a U.S. citizen.
2. Must reside in Wyandot County at the time of the application, regardless of whether the high school he/she attends is located in Wyandot County.
3. Must be planning to attend school as a full-time student.

SELECTION CRITERIA

All scholarship applications are carefully reviewed by both the Foundation's professional staff and designated scholarship advisory committee.

1. Academic Achievements
2. Scholastic Aptitude (test scores)
3. Leadership Characteristics
 - a. Community Service & Volunteer Involvement
 - b. Extracurricular Activities
 - c. Work Experience
4. Financial Need

RENEWAL ELIGIBILITY

1. Must re-apply for this scholarship.
2. Must only have received this scholarship one time in previous year.
3. Must show progress toward degree.

SCHOLARSHIP TIMELINE

February 11, 2020: Application deadline

Late March – Early April: Scholarship Advisory Committee reviews applications and selects recipients.

Mid-May: All applicants are notified by email if they were approved or denied.

June 30, 2020: Recipients must submit follow up information to confirm that you are in compliance with the terms of the scholarship and to verify your enrollment at an accredited post-secondary institution.

Late July: Scholarships are paid directly to the post-secondary institution (never directly to student).
