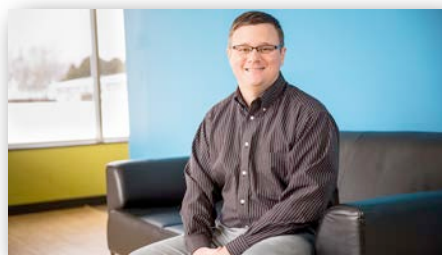

2018 GRANT RECIPIENTS

Wyandot County Community Foundation awarded \$10,331.00 in grants at their awards ceremony & breakfast held at the Wyandot County Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on October 19. Grant awards focused primarily on adding or updating technology and meeting the needs of underserved populations. Receiving grants were:



Carey EV School District - \$1000 grant for the purchase of inclusive play ground equipment for the school's handicapped students.

Carey Historical Society - \$400 grant to replace curtains, fixtures and blinds for the Newhard Museum.

Fairhaven Community - \$2000 to supplement transportation services offered to Fairhaven's older adults.

Forest Jackson Public Library - \$500 to provide a summer reading program for children of the Village of Wharton.

Hannah's House - \$739 to purchase educational supplies for "Children In Between" classes.

HHWP Community Action Commission - \$2000 for the Wheels for Wyandot County initiative that will bring needed public transportation to Wyandot County.

NCOESC Union Preschool - \$850 to develop a Math and Manipulative Learning Center for preschool children.

Sycamore Volunteer Fire Department - \$1500 for a "Zoll Autopulse" an Automatic CPR machine.

Wyandot County Council on Aging - \$485 to purchase a Presentation Projector and Portable Screen.

Wyandot County General Health District - \$857 to purchase an Audiometer for hearing screenings of Wyandot Co. students K through 11th grade.

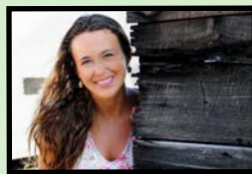
