

Logsdon Scholarship Fund Application

The Logsdon Scholarship Fund, created by the late Giles and Carol Logsdon, will begin taking applications May 30 2024. Former attendees of St. Peter Elementary School in Upper Sandusky, who've successfully completed one year of post-secondary education, are eligible to apply for a scholarship, which will help cover the student's next year's tuition. Natives of Wyandot County, the Logsdons lived down the road from where Giles was born and farmed both theirs and part of the original family farm while operating several businesses over the years. These included a wood burning stove store, first operated out of the former Harpster General Store and then from their home, an embroidery business, an orchard, and a Christmas tree farm. Carol likewise was a lifelong farmer who grew up in Eden Township.

Purpose

Giles and Carol Logsdon established The Logsdon Scholarship Fund to provide scholarships annually to qualified students who have accomplished all of the following items:

1. Have attended St Peter Catholic School in Upper Sandusky, Ohio;
2. Have graduated from High School; and
3. Have attended an accredited technical college, trade school, college, or university; completing at least one year of a two or more year course of study.

How to apply

1. Applicants must submit:
 - a) Completed scholarship application
 - b) A college transcript of grades
 - c) Verification of tuition payments made by you or parents in the last school year.
 - d) Two letters of recommendation from individuals other than parents who know the character, leadership skills, financial need, and school or community involvement of applicant.
